

To Check Your Vision:

Please sit around 5 feet from your computer screen.

You will need a quarter in order to adjust the eye chart to be accurate and a pen/pencil and paper to record your results.

After you click the link below, you will see an eye chart with a circle on the right-hand-side of the page. Please adjust the size of the circle on your screen so that it is about the same size as a quarter.

You will then check your vision one eye at a time with your glasses or contacts if you normally wear them. Please write down the numbers (eg. 20/25) to the left of the smallest line that you are able to see for each eye.

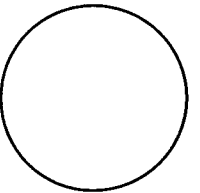
